FREE TIER 1 SUPPORT FOR ALL SCHOOLS IN DISTRICT 8 OPTED IN TO THE INCLUSION HUB.

Tier 1 offer

Initial checklist to ascertain if strategies and interventions have already been attempted in the school setting.

Access to this Tier is on an as required basis over the course of the year

- Telephone advice and support from an Elm Tree outreach worker covering behavior management, additional need resources and strategies of support for schools.
- Behaviour surgeries ½ termly discussion about specific cases with members of the Elm Tree outreach team and specialist practitioners. (Dates TBC).
 - Initial visit from outreach worker to observe pupil and discuss strategies for support with Class teacher/SENCo (Up to 2 hours)
 - Signposting to other relevant professional services/advice assessment practitioners.
 - Courtesy call back for feedback and monitoring purposes (By end of ½ term)
 - Access to higher Tier support

<u>Tier 2 Support Package schools pay £500</u>

(Inclusion Hub will reimburse 50% of Package cost 1,000)

For additional pupil support (2nd and 3rd pupil) - funding from the Hub will reduce by 50% each time.

- After fulfilling the initial Tier 1 criteria a planning meeting with Elm Tree Coordinator to plan the school's inclusion requirements and the focus of the 12 hours of support.
- Possible options could be pupil observation followed by discussion with SENCo/Class team
- Assessment of challenges, barriers and strategies to support within the classroom, with peer relationships and during more unstructured times, documented in a full written report.
 - 12 hours of targeted school support
- Specialist Practitioner support and identification of needs inclusive of Mosaic,
 Functional communication, SaLT, Dyslexia and Boxall assessments.
 - Support with EHCP initiation and preparation

Training options from the Elm Tree Team

- Attachment and Trauma informed practice (JB) 2 Hours
 - Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACE's) 3 hours
 - Sensory Integration (SB) 3 Hours
- SaLT Functional communication, Colourful Semantics (SC) 2 hours
- EHCP & Early Help Assessment support (HC) (Phone/Zoom contact Elm Tree)
 - Team Teach (SB/CO) 6 Hours*
 - *(The cost is £120pp with a minimum requirement of 12 staff members to attend)

- Ensure that pupils' needs are better met by a local offer.
- Provide high quality training and guidance for staff in schools.
